Program Notes

The trumpet fanfare *Ablassen* literally means blast of steam. It has appeared with a collection called *Bach's Trumpet*, but, more often it is attributed to German composer Gottfried Reiche. It is popularly recognized from television's CBS News Sunday Morning program. The fanfare segue's into Bach's *Prelude in C* which serves as the accompaniment for the well known *Ave Maria* melody written by Charles Gounod (1853) played tonight on flugelhorn.

The piano artistry of Patrecia Ross shines through on her favorites from Bach, (the Baroque Era 1600-1760), to Mozart (the Classical Era 1730-1820), to Beethoven and Tchaikovsky, (the Romantic Era 1850-1910).

Pastor Dave Mulder shares a concert favorite by Leroy Anderson entitled *Trumpeter's Lullaby* written in 1949. The inspiration for this work came from Boston Pops trumpeter Roger Voisin who asked Anderson about writing him a trumpet solo that would be different from traditional trumpet solos which tend to be loud and triumphant. So, Leroy wrote this lullaby. It has been recorded by Roger Voisin, Doc Severinsen, Al Hirt, Winton Marsellis and many others.

The Man I Love is a popular standard written in 1924 by George Gershwin. It is the basis for the 1947 film *The Man I Love* starring Ida Lupino and Bruce Bennett. C

Carnival of Venice—Theme and Variations is based on a folk tune popularly associated with the words "My hat, it has three corners." Jean Arban's version of this fun piece includes some technical flare with fast tonguing and lots of arpeggios.

His Eye Is on the Sparrow is inspired by the words of Jesus in the Gospel of Matthew in the Bible: "Are not two sparrows sold for a penny? Yet not one of them will fall to the ground apart from your Father." (Matthew 10:29)

The English folk tune under tonight's title *Gift of Love* is included to tell the story of Pastor Dave's 1887 antique gold plated cornet which truly is a gift of love!

Sandy Patti's *Unshakable Kingdom* is a glorious note for our finale. It is a powerful affirmation of our faith to kindle a great hope and express God's eternal love for us.
