The 1913 Storm was the greatest natural disaster in the recorded history of the Great lakes. A total of 250 sailors lost their lives and 25 ships vanished, nine in lower Lake Huron alone. This is the story of one of these ships, the Howard M. Hanna Jr., and how her crew survived after almost striking the Port Austin Reef Light. Using specially created artwork and period photos from his own collection, brings the 1913 Storm to life through the eyes of the Hanna's Crew.
